The Opportunity:

We are seeking a highly skilled and motivated individual for CENGN's Training department for a 4-month co-op term. Reporting directly to the Senior Manager of CENGN's Training Programs, this individual will start the term through a boot camp to learn the latest in cloud technologies like OpenStack, Docker and Kubernetes, as well as next generation networking technologies such as Network Function Virtualization and general professional and collaboration skills. Upon completion of this boot camp, the student will attempt the CENGN Cloud System Specialist certification exam.

CENGN Academy focuses on practical, use-case driven training in commercial cutting-edge technologies, with an open source flavour. Hands-on training is supported by CENGN's unique cloud-based lab infrastructure. Throughout the term, the Cloud Technology Research student will assist in creating and updating CENGN Academy's training content. The student will also help develop, optimize and maintain the underlying infrastructure.

This position involves participation in events which may require the student to be available outside normal working hours on a few occasions during the placement. Applicants should expect to be required to work irregular hours 3-5 times during the contract.

Key Responsibilities:

Due to the rapid evolution of the emerging network technologies for which CENGN is in the forefront, the Cloud Technology Research Student plays an important role in developing and maintaining CENGN's technical training content, which continuously evolves. The main responsibilities are:

- Collaborate in a professional manner among a team of experienced engineers and trainers
- Investigate and document leading edge technologies, such as cloud systems, software defined networking, security, high-speed wireless and open source technologies
- Demonstrate and articulate in depth understanding of these technologies both internally to the CENGN team as well as externally to CENGN members and partners
- Create and update training materials using CENGN's standard templates
- Develop and maintain CENGN's cloud infrastructure for hands-on training exercises
- Create and optimize automated lab setup and maintenance routines
- Assist in the development of assessment instruments
- Support CENGN Academy training events
- Contribute to technical projects in NGN technologies as led by CENGN's engineering team
- Support presentations at public events like meetups and other technical forums
- Other duties as required

Key Competencies/Qualifications:

- Desire to learn and develop while exercising and demonstrating solid problem-solving skills
- Ability to work autonomously within a team leveraging online collaboration tools
- Solid practical experience with TCP/IP networking
- Good understanding of hypervisor architecture and principles
- Exposure to and interest in Linux system components and virtualization features (libvirt, KVM/QEMU, kernel/user namespaces)
- Experience in consuming or contributing to Open Source projects
- Excellent interpersonal, organizational, and communication skills
- Strong English language writing and editing skills
- Experience in/with any of the following would be considered an asset:
 - Technical writing

- Datacenter environment
- Public and/or private cloud services
- Cloud Native / microservice architecture using technologies like Docker and Kubernetes
- Programming or scripting
- Illustration and/or video editing software
- Next generation security solutions (NGFW, UTM, IDS/IPS, MDM)
- Agile methodology
- Atlassian toolset (Confluence, JIRA, etc.)
- Teaching assistant or another instructional role
- Code available for review on public repositories (e.g. Github)

Education:

- Post-secondary term in Software Engineering, Computer Science, Engineering, IT or related discipline

Eligibility

Students who are enrolled or have graduated from post-secondary institution programs which provide the relevant background and aptitude to work and enhance their skills as per the requirements of CENGN's listed student postings will qualify for internships under this program.

- Students can be at the undergraduate level (current students) or graduate level (current masters and PhD students), or they may be recent undergraduate and master graduates within three years of graduation from an Ontario-based post-secondary institution
- The student must be eligible to work in Ontario and have employee status at the company for the duration of the internship (Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or on a work/student visa)
- The student may not apply with a company where there is any conflict of interest, including, but not limited to, a company where the student or relatives have any control as a major creditor or shareholder or governing board
- As a condition of employment and in accordance to CENGN's Code of Conduct Policy, all students must maintain a clean criminal record. CENGN engages a third party provider to verify student backgrounds prior to the start of the internship
