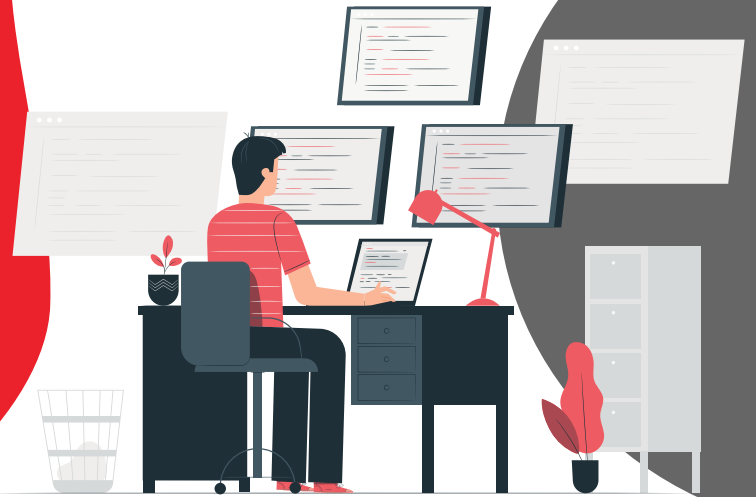

- Assist in tracking active projects versus backlog sequencing.
- Ensure data accuracy and consistency across reporting materials.

#### Governance & Meeting Preparation

- Prepare materials for governance forums (e.g., Steering, Business Review Management, Portfolio Review Board).
- Compile project status summaries and executive reporting views.
- Support documentation of decisions and action tracking.

#### Data & Visualization

- Develop and refine Excel-based dashboards and visual summaries.
- Translate project data into clear, professional presentation materials.
- Assist in analyzing trends related to project throughput and workload distribution.

#### Process & Documentation Support

- Help maintain PMO templates, tools, and documentation libraries.
- Support structured documentation of intake and review processes.
